CIVIC LEADERSHIP ENGAGEMENT ROADMAP

CLER is The Policy Circle's three-month, self-paced leadership program that boosts civic knowledge and propels women into leadership. This highly immersive, experiential program combines small group learning and 1-1 coaching to ensure that our graduates become thoughtful and influential local leaders - prepared to tackle the tough issues in their communities and states.

This year, we doubled the number of applicants, and **270 women** participated in CLER.

The support of the **Bowe-Stewart Foundation** played an important role in this year's growth. Their generous investment enabled us to launch a targeted CLER outreach to members of the military community. In addition, they underwrote the highly successful *Full Circle Leadership Series*. With the Bowe-Stewart Foundation, The Policy Circle will continue targeted efforts to reach specific communities to broaden the reach and impact of CLER.

FULL CIRCLE LEADERSHIP SERIES

The Full Circle Leadership Series focuses on the skills, mindset, and strategic thinking needed to become more effective, persuasive, and influential leaders. These interactive, virtual events featured a mix of practical insights from women who have walked the walk - from securing appointments and legislative victories to building compelling stories and strong collaborations.

DAY AT THE CAPITOL: TEXAS

The Policy Circle's Day at The Capitol in Austin, TX, was a dynamic event that immersed participants in the heart of legislative action. The packed day of learning included a Capitol tour, a panel on housing policy, a luncheon focused on securing state appointments, and a lovely reception hosted by the First Lady of Texas. In 2024, we will replicate this successful model by taking this event on the road to key state capitols across the country.

STRATEGIC COLLABORATION: MONTANA

The Policy Circle traveled to Montana and hosted a regional event featuring a fireside chat with Montana's Governor Greg Gianforte and a panel conversation with strategic partner, EdChoice. This event focused on workforce development and innovative career pathways activating a whole new network for The Policy Circle in Montna.

The Policy Circle Experiences are regional events hosted by a National Advisory Council member. These experiences enable The Policy Circle to reach new audiences and build more circles in a particular area.
